9. Lion President Jim West attended ceremonies in Forest Lake High School and awarded two Lions Scholarships.
10. Lion Jim Opp reminds us of the chicken dinner we are serving at Meister's SummerFest on Saturday, July 27. A signup sheet will be available at a future meeting. The world famous Scandia Community Band will perform as well as some other local talent and some imported talent (an official Dance Band).
11. Lion President Jim West and 1st Vice President Marilyn Opp will meet next Wednesday, June 14 with representatives of the East Park Lions to discuss our involvement with the BINGO at the Washington County Fair.
12. Our next meeting, June 22 is a Spouses Night. New officers will be installed and retiring officers honored.
