Minutes of the Business Meeting

1. Lion President Marilyn Opp introduced new members to be inducted tonight; Jeff Pratt and Mary Jo Milbrandt.
2. Lion Marilyn introduced our latest Scholarship recipient, Justin Kendrick.
3. Lion Gordy Rydeen introduced his guests. Lion Gordy said some stuff.
4. We received a Thank You from Jackie Mills for the Scholarship she received.
5. The Secretary's Report was approved as distributed in the Lions Newsletter.
6. Lion Treasurer J.R. West gave the Treasurer's Report. We have \$1,469.02 in the Contribution Account; \$2,872.50 in the Administrative Account; \$403.84 in the Scholarship Account; and \$9,744.87 in the Taco Daze Account for a total of \$14,490.23 in all Lions accounts. There is \$2,074.62 in the Ball Park Account. The report was approved.
7. Lion Cliff Guggisberg gave the Gambling Manager's Report. June receipts were \$1511; expenses were \$931, for a net income of \$579.02. The month ending balance was \$8,686.37.
8. The Contribution Review Committee suggests we give \$250 to Camp Courage. Lion Howie Eckstrom made a motion to that effect. The motion was seconded by Lion Denny Seefeldt and was passed. \$250 to Camp Courage from the Gambling Account.
9. The CRC recommends that we again give \$300 to Lion John Beattie to help with expenses incurred in providing carriage rides to the handicapped. The motion was made by Lion Cal Floerke, seconded by Lion Howie Eckstrom and was passed. \$300 to John Beattie from the Contribution Account.
10. At the Board meeting yesterday, Lion J.R. West requested that the previously authorized donation of \$300 to Sight First II be designated to come from the Gambling Account. The motion was seconded by Lion Bruce Swenson and passed. \$300 to Sight First II from the Gambling Account.
11. Lion Jim Opp reported that sixteen Lions worked at the Chicken Dinner sales at Meister's Summerfest. 200 dinners were sold. Some of the left over chicken was used at the International Students picnic and some more will be used for our dinner here tonight. Proceeds from the sale were just \$41.60. Hopefully, we learned how this event can be more profitable next year.
12. Lion Jim West reports that he still has twelve slots (of the 45 we need to fill) for the BINGO activity at the Washington County Fair. The Fair will be August 2 – 6. Lion Jim worked the crowd during dinner to get the remaining slots filled.
13. Lion Mike Hermes performed a small induction ceremony for our latest two new members.
